1.0 POLICY

1.1 Whenever fixed wing and rotary wing aircraft are being utilized on an incident, personnel trained in air operations management shall be assigned by the incident commander/operations section chief.

- 1.2 Prior to the initiation of air operations, all personnel operating in close proximity to an airdrop shall be notified of such activity.
- Members shall not intentionally operate in an area where it can reasonably be expected 1.3 that they may be hit with retardants or suppressants from fixed wing or rotary aircraft.
- Radio communications shall be maintained between an aircraft/air attack officer and the 1.4 appropriate ground officer.
- Members assigned to ride in rotary wing aircraft shall be briefed in the correct approach, 1.5 riding, off-loading and emergency procedures for the particular type of aircraft.
